President: Patty Harmon called the meeting to order at 3:01pm.

Attendees introduced themselves and new members to the board were welcomed.

The following Action Items from the previous Board meeting were reviewed.

- Ringers were defined and it was agreed to move forward with Ringers for those members playing from the Combo tees.
- Patty noted that the use of surveys would be ongoing due to the ease of Mailchimp software.
- The process of evaluating various websites for use by QCLGA will continue with Andrea Jondal joining Stephanie Sacca in the effort.

Treasurer: Debbie Dezell presented the proposed 2026 budget, reflecting the individual committee requests, for review. It was agreed that expenses exceeding the budgeted amount would require Board pre-approval. The expense reimbursement process was reviewed. Additional changes to the proposed budget were discussed and accepted. Debbie will redraw the budget and distribute it for acceptance.

Vice-President: Mary Newman provided a schedule of meeting dates, including events requiring meals. There was general discussion regarding 2026 meal pricing

and meal options. It was agreed that meal price would be charged to members at the current banquet pricing. If in the future the league is able to subsidize a meal it will be considered.

- Some changes have been made to the Calendar regarding Interclub qualifiers.
- Bobbi Jo will work with Marie Cook and Debbie Dezell to assure STRIPE is available for tournament entry fees.
